



Scale of Fees for Loans of Objects from Linden-Museum Stuttgart – State Museum of Ethnology

1. The Linden-Museum Stuttgart charges a handling fee for the loan of objects. This handling fee includes the administrative charges, charges for drawing up condition reports, costs for cleaning and restoration of the objects (for a maximum working time up to 30 minutes).

2. The handling fees ¹ are		
for the first object		€ 230,-
for each additional object		€ 65,-
for further restoration works (working time of more than 30 minutes)	per hour	€ 65,-
for installing of mounts	per hour	€ 55,-
for packing	per object	€ 180,-
for lending transportation crates	per crate	€ 200,-

3. Ethnological/Ethnographical museums that have signed the agreement of mutual exempt from fees will not be charged the above fees. This is also valid for state or communal museums in Baden-Württemberg and for schools and other state or communal educational institutions in Baden-Württemberg.

4. Requests for loans have to be addressed in written form to the board of directors of the Linden-Museum Stuttgart. They should be on hand at least 6 months before the lending period begins.
